The “VOTER ID” law went into effect on July 1, 2011, County Election Board Secretary Joy Naifeh said today.

“This new law requires all registered voters to show proof of identify in order to vote at the polling place on election day or to vote early at the County Election Board office,” Naifeh said.

“Voters may use the VOTER IDENTIFICATION CARD they received by mail when they registered to vote,” Naifeh said. “The voter identification card is provided to every voter free of charge when they register to vote. Replacement cards are also free of charge, and may be obtained by calling the Creek County Election Board office at 918-224-3529,” she added.
